## **ALPINE SKIING**

## **SOMT STATE WINTER GAMES RULES AND ENTRY INFORMATION**

- ❖ Athletes may participate in up to three events.
- ❖ Athletes may **not** enter a traditional Special Olympics event and the corresponding Unified event. ie: Alpine Slalom and Unified Alpine Slalom. These are two divisions of the same event.
- ❖ A level of competition (N, I or A) must be submitted for all athletes entered. N refers to Novice, I refers to Intermediate, and A refers to Advanced.
- ❖ Coaches for all Advanced Alpine skiers will complete a form verifying that the athlete can ski the advanced course.
- ❖ Events identified with \*\* are designed for athletes with lower ability levels who are unable to participate in the other events.
- ❖ Finish placement for the downhill, slalom, and giant slalom competition will be determined by the time of one run.
- ❖ Unified Sports® Downhill, Slalom, and Giant Slalom will be combined scores of one Unified Sports® partner and one Special Olympics athlete.
- ❖ Participants in Unified Alpine events must be an intermediate skier or better.
- ❖ Sit Ski athletes compete with the use of sleds. Glide athletes compete with the use of skis.
- ❖ **A helmet appropriate for alpine skiing MUST be worn for all Alpine/Downhill competition AND training.**

## SOMT STATE WINTER GAMES RULES AND ENTRY INFORMATION

- ❖ Athletes may participate in up to three events
- ❖ Athletes may use classical or freestyle technique in all races
- ❖ Athletes may not enter a traditional Special Olympics event and the corresponding Unified event. ie: 1 Kilometer race and the 1 Kilometer Unified Sports® race.
- ❖ Events identified with \*\* are designed for athletes with lower ability levels who are unable to participate in the other events.
- ❖ Unified Sports® events will be combined scores of one Unified Sports® partner and one Special Olympics athlete. Unified Sports® Relay will consist of two Unified Sports® partners and two Special Olympics athletes.
- ❖ Glide and 10 Meter participants can use Nordic or Alpine skis.
- ❖ Rules governing competition include Special Olympics International Cross Country Skiing rules and United States Ski Association rules.
