1 x Male—Category 2(100m, 200m, 400m, 4x100m, 4x400m)

1 x Female—Category 3 (200m, 400m, 800m, 4x100m, 4x400m)

Remember, an athlete must win first place in their division in the 2012 SOMT SWG in order to be nominated to be part of the 2013 World Games. If you have an athlete who wins their division and brings home a gold medal, do not hesitate to nominate that athlete.
